SCICR (Select Committee to Investigate Constitutional Revision) Items by Chair Tom Allen for How to Proceed

As SCICR Chair, I will

- Construct timelines, and agenda ideas to get started.
- Compose a head start revision model to start debates on the philosophies of how and why our Constitution needs to be revised. This will set an initial course for amending various ideas as we move forward. This will prevent the confusion of starting with no direction known.
- Suggest a 3/4 majority on any eventual revision item in the SCICR, but consensus is preferred.
- Possibly allow the full three years before the 2024 TDA to complete a full revision, although some revisions could be implemented before that by amendment to the existing Constitution as agreed upon by the SCICR and at least 6 Councilors or the EC.
- Consult with the Executive Committee on advisable SCICR candidates.
- Give a full report to the GC and EC whenever asked.
- Always engage the Judicial Committee.
- Engage public comment on SocAdmin and the Fellowship's Facebook and other appropriate mediums as approved by the SCICR as items are being debated.
- Insist that SCICR members review origins, history, and destiny of our Constitution and become familiar with the Constitution and bylaws of the UAI and Urantia Foundation's Declaration of Trust.
- Actively reach out to candidates who are willing to be selected to the SCICR and make recommendations to the EC.
